## WHAT WE DO

WARFIGHTER ENGAGED is an all-volunteer charitable 501c3 non-profit organization with a mission to improve the lives of severely wounded warfighters through personally adapted devices.

We modify video game and recreational items, make prosthetic enhancements, hygiene items and other novel devices for greater independence of the warfighter.

Amputations, TBI, and mobility issues all fall within our mission. With no two injuries being alike and no readily available solutions to address these specific needs, the vast majority of modifications to these devices can only be determined by one on one interactions with each individual user.

Their service is performed for wounded veterans at Walter Reed NMMC, other military hospitals, individual homes and other locations as needed.

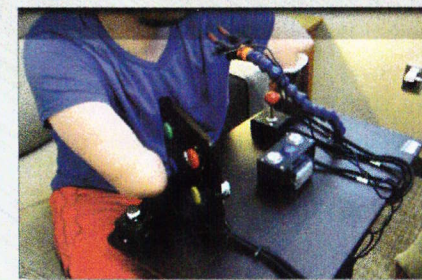
All adapted items are provided at no cost to the warfighter.
